As parents, we take our educational responsibility seriously and ensure that ...

- we all, children and adults, are respectful with each other. We take care of good manners, appropriate language behaviour and a peaceful company.
- we stick to a regular exchange of information and agreements with teachers and counsellors.
- our child takes part in catholic school events (e.g. attending services of the word for all classes, attending advent celebrations).
- our child doesn't bring electronic devices (mobile phone, MP3-Player) to school.
- we encourage our child to follow class and school rules.
- we take part in our child's life at school,
 - by ensuring that our child goes to school regularly and on time
 - by ensuring that our child has fully functional school supplies and a clean and neat schoolbag
 - by informing the school until 7:45 am in case of our child's illness

- by reading and answering school messages
- by being available for the school in case of emergency (telephone numbers and address have to be up to date)

- by ensuring that our child does his/ her homework every day

- by attending school events (e.g. parent conference days and school celebrations)

- by giving our child a healthy breakfast to take with him/ her to school

- the children develop pleasure for learning

- we teach the children how to solve conflicts in a fair way and on their own to ensure that violence becomes no option

- the children learn to accept and respect differences between people and their cultural background

- the children develop cooperativeness

- the children handle objects of their own and others carefully

- the children develop respect for nature

- a regular exchange of information with parents can take place

- we teach the children class & school rules
